After eighteen years of building and maintaining the information systems network for the center, he retired as Executive Director in 1995. In June of 1995 Tim and Nancy started a small corporation in automotive service and repair. They are still in the business and are currently merging with another company and expanding the business to service large diesel trucks and fleets. Tim and Nancy are heavily involved in church as care pastors and teachers in a local body of believers that has a far reaching ministry. They, have two children, Melissa (28) and

Melannie (23), and two grandchildren, Macie (9) and KayLee (7), all living in the same local area. Melissa and husband, Scott, live in a small town just miles from home. Melannie, currently seeking a clinical license, also works and lives near home.
