The message is similar, only now there are pictured, two heads, one from the first Flamingo, a second, with an additional message, "Apparently you chose to ignore our warnings, another Flamingo has paid the price..." Make No mistake, ZiggyDale's message is Loud Clear: that while the current state of Country Music remains in Desperate Times, ZiggyDale, has proven that he is a man willing to take Desperate Measures.
