About GENE HARDY Canada's foremost R&B saxophonist, GENE HARDY began his musical journey on violin at age 9 then on saxophone a year later in Victoria, British Columbia. After studies at Victoria's Conservatory of Music UVic, he moved to Toronto in 1986 and traded in his classical pursuits for a post-graduate degree in funk with Toronto's infamous Bourbon Tabernacle Choir. Chances are, you've heard him play. Since the Bourbon's mid '90s break-up, Gene has become the horn player of choice for many of Canada's best known exports domestic successes. He's recorded and performed in the US Canada with Michael Bubl and is the latest addition to Canadian Music Hall of Fame inductee Ronnie Hawkins' band, The Hawks. In fact, Gene has recorded and performed with hundreds of acts pop rock, jazz blues, country to punk and everything in between with the likes of BARENAKED LADIES, MICHAEL BUBLE, ESTHERO, BIG SUGAR, COLIN JAMES, DOWNCHILD BLUES BAND, RONNIE HAWKINS, TYLER YAREMA HIS RHYTHM, RHEOSTATICS, The LINCOLNS, HOCK WALSH, ROGER CLOWN, VEDA HILLE, QUE VIDA, KEVIN QUAIN The MAD BASTARDS, BIG DADDY G, FORD PIER (of DOA), DUTCH MASON, STOOPY, TABARRUK, MICHAEL KAESHAMMER, The BOURBON TABERNACLE CHOIR, Dr HILLY SAND ESQ. and Jamaica's THIRD WORLD. 300 shows a year. For the past 5 consecutive years, Gene's been nominated as HORN PLAYER OF THE YEAR by the Canadian Blues Awards in recognition for his extensive contributions, both live and in the recording studio. All about BLOW! BLOW! BLOW! GENE HARDY's debut CD, entitled BLOW! BLOW! BLOW! BLOW!, captures his swinging powerful Texas-tenor playing style. It's also a robust collection of blues, jump tunes, jazz classics and his own compositions that neatly showcases Mr. Hardy's versatility and depth. Featured on the CD are performances from some of Canada's finest musical talent, including cameos by guitar slinger Danny Marks and Toronto blues-belter Laura Hubert (Leslie Spit Tree-o). If that's not enough, Gene's already recording the follow-up CD - possibly a double album - in Toronto and Vancouver with his new 15 piece band. A 2006 release date and title will be announced as the project nears completion. And what else is he up to? Hardy has also released two CDs with his band SPARKJIVER. The title of their newest CD aptly describes what they do:

FUNKYBLUESYJAZZYCHURCHY Wanna hear some? Well, you're in luck...Gene has included several SPARKJIVER cuts on Blow! Blow! (see the liner notes for which ones they are) A summer residency for SPARKJIVER at Toronto's famed Orbit Room (owned by RUSH guitarist Alex Lifeson) saw many notable guest artists join the band onstage, sometimes for a song, sometimes for a whole set. Gene Hardy - BLOW! BLOW! Track-By-Track 1. HONKY TONK (Part 2) It's always good to start with a blues tune! A bonus horn section addition to Gene's reworking of Bill Doggett's chestnut. 2. Lester Leaps In A lively up-tempo "Rhythm Changes" number with "the combo". 3. Sweet Lotus Blossom A smoky viper tune. This one features a blissed-out vocal take from Laura Hubert and the sweeping genius of Dennis Keldie at the Hammond organ. 4. Quay Waltz Soulful gospel blues caught live at the fabulous Silver Dollar in Toronto during SPARKJIVER's most recent residency. No studio trickery here - this is how it went down! 5. Down In Dallas A Patsy Cline tune! Features pedal steel legend Al Brisco on the "funny neck"! 6. Georgia It's Hoagy time with the combo...a standard in standard time. 7. Geep's Blues A spirited no-holds-barred tenor outing. One of Gene's tunes inspired by tenor titan Big Jay McNeeley 8. Wham! Relentless rockin' surf music from the pen of guitar great Lonnie Mack. Features Danny Marks on guitar and "Hamilton Dan" Lockwood on drums. 9. Since I Fell For You Keldie Hubert appear again in this whisper-to-a-scream rendition of Buddy Johnson's great standard. 10.
