Time spent in London, Dublin, Paris, India and Berlin along the way provides the fuel that still drives his writing today. Over the past six years, he has played countless shows including gigs with the likes of Sara Watkins from Nickel Creek and Matt Hensley from Flogging Molly. FOLKTRONIC My siblings Led Zeppelin, The Police, Roy Orbison and miscellaneous Chart records all part of what spun in my head growing up. There was always music at home. Mum plays piano, and 3 classical guitars sort of wandered around the house. I'm interested in fusion - vocals, guitar, and electronica. My songs tend to have a percussive backbeat from the way I play guitar. It has a kind of trance effect on me when I am playing for myself."
