They were soon doing shows at small clubs throughout the Boston downtown area. Just as things began moving forward, Kaotik was in a near fatal car accident and has spent the last few years in physical rehabilitation. Even in the hospital in serious condition, Kaotik never stopped writing lyrics in his head. It was in this condition that he wrote several of the tracks on the demo. Finally back in the studio, with hot

production and the attitude that what doesn't kill you makes you stronger, a never ending love for music, and a sick sense of humor, he's determined to go after what he was forced to put on hold. Kaotik is far more than a battle rapper. Although he has clever wordplay, he also has the ability to write stories or songs with a meaning.
