This is music that is meant to be listened to outside on a sunny afternoon with a group of your closest friends. Kudos to the band and label for producing a great looking album as well. Simple graphics and a pop color scheme match the mood of the album perfectly. If Sometimes Seven continues to grow at the rate they have between their early recordings and this album they will be a serious musical force in no time at all. I hope the number of bass players contributing to this album is not an indicator of a fluctuating lineup because they already sound just perfect the way they are.
