This CD is recorded on 80minute/700MB CDR and includes more than one hour of music, so your CD audio device will need to play these (most modern players do). Utenzil uses Ableton Live, Propellerheads Reason, Sony mics, Audio Technica mics, M-Audio mics and interfaces, Marshall mics, Tascam interface, Alesis effects and drum machine, Ibanez Guitars, Peavey and Mesa Boogie

amps, Korg effects, and an aging Casio (that's right, Casio) CZ-5000 synth.
