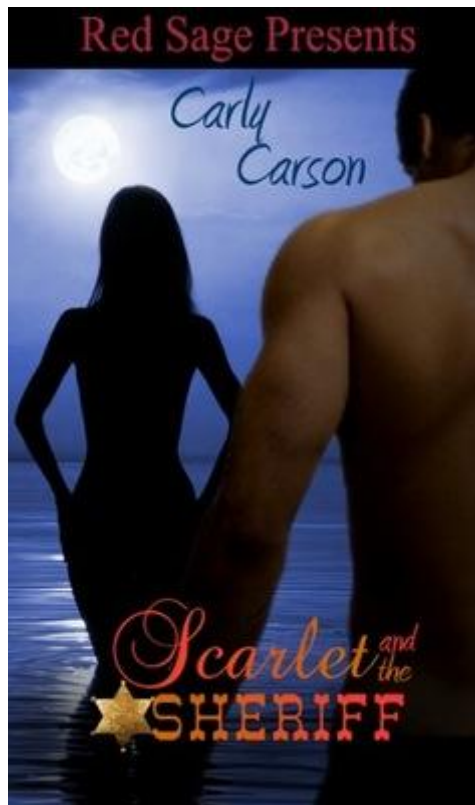


Scarlet And The Sheriff - Carly Carson
