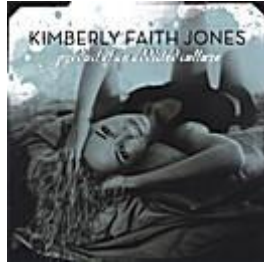


Mp3 Kimberly Faith Jones - Product Of An Addicted Culture
