
Mp3 Lee Murdock - Wayfaring Stranger

Released on vinyl in 1987, now in limited release on CD-R, Wayfaring Stranger is an instrumental guitar lover's paradise. Irish Carolan tunes, ragtime, classical, some classic folk blues standards, and searing 12-string guitar on the title cut. 11 MP3 Songs FOLK: Traditional Folk, CLASSICAL: Contemporary Details: Released on vinyl in 1987, and now available in limited release on CD-R, this CD is an instrumental guitar lover's paradise. Instrumental guitar is featured heavily, with several compositions by Celtic harpist Turlough Carolan, a ragtime tune composed by Pete Norman, the classical Pavanne by Ravel, and a soaring and rolling 12-string guitar instrumental in the seven-minute title cut, Wayfaring Stranger. Lee's arrangement of Wayfaring Stranger was inspired by a performance by the legendary singer, Odetta, at the Summerfolk Festival in Owen Sound, Ontario. The recording was a solid collection of traditional songs, including the first recording of some of Lee's still-favorite Great Lakes maritime tunes (Persia's Crew, and The Lumberman's Alphabet), and the bluesy After You've Gone.
