It is electronica sans software and samplers. All sounds are made by the instruments. The band recalls Amon Tobin, John Zorn, Van Halen, Prince Paul, Ornette Coleman, John Coltrane, Stravinsky, and Mancini among some. But as previously said, we'll leave the colorful analogies up to you. The ills have been packing venues since their birth. By playing with the likes of Tortoise, the band has garnered attention around the world simply by way of the internet. You can check out theillsfor more of that. The band's individual members have also enjoyed touring and sharing experiences with other Oklahoma bands, the internationally acclaimed band, The Flaming Lips, as well as the national wonder, The Starlight Mints. All four members (Blaine Nelson, Ryan Jones, Boyd

Littell, and Kasra George Ahmadi) have been making music for quite some time. Starting in either rock bands, churches, or middle school public education, their paths have led them to this project. There are no leaders in this band, the project came together in a fluid manner that parallels its philosophy... The ills do not and cannot make their music unless these are their four members.
