The Babies Are Here - James Coffey: Vocals, Guitar, Mandolin, Percussion Keyboards. Every spring new babies are born in Miss Willow's Fence Row. You just have to sing about it! 3. Berry Berry Good Time - James Coffey: Vocals, Banjo, Guitar, Mandolin, Harmonica, Percussion Keyboards; It

"is" a berry berry good time when it's berry time in the Fence Row! 4. Some Day Some Way - Amy Lee Moser, Vocals; James Coffey: Guitar, Recorder, Percussion Keyboards; A Forever Family Song where a little orphaned fox knows there just "has" to be a family waiting for him somewhere!! A Disney-like theme song. 5. Spring Cleaning Time - James Coffey: Vocals, Guitar, Mandolin, Harmonica, Violin, Percussion Keyboards. Woodrow Woodchuck and Pearla Possum call a meeting underneath the big fir tree. The Fence Row needs cleaned up! 6.Empty Nest Feeling - James Coffey: Vocals, Guitar, Mandolin, Harmonica, Accordion, Percussion Keyboards; Although the idea of this came from a friend's thoughts about kids going off to college, Kaley envisioned Charlotte Chickadee having the very same type of empty nest feelings when her babies flew away. So.. Charlotte adopts some fur puff babies....they didn't have feathered wings, but she loved them like her own. Most Mom's can relate to this song too... 7. Bushy Tails and Fluffy Feathers - Kaley Willow: Vocals; James Coffey: Piano, Percussion Keyboards; This is the Fence Row Theme Song. When Miss Willow saw that the Blue Jays, Indigo Buntings, and Rufus-Sided Towees all seemed to get along in the fence row, she knew it "had" to be a very special place to live. 8. Fence Row Lullaby - Kaley Willow: Vocals; James Coffey: Piano, Guitar, Mandolin, Percussion Keyboards; Dr. Earl Squirrel suggests this song be sung by Fence Row Mom's and Dads ... Grammy's and Grandpa's to their little ones. Maybe you'd like to sing it too. 9. The Hermit on the Hill - James Coffey; Vocals, Guitar, Mandolin, Violin, Percussion Keyboards; Uncle Bertrum (Woodrow Woodchuck's Uncle) had a welcome sign that said "Go Away". Big Blizzard's Coming - James Coffey, Vocals Banjo, Guitar, Mandolin, Violin, Harmonica, Percussion Keyboards; Flossie Fox and Blossum Skunk wander off and get lost "just before"

it starts to snow. The Fence Row Storm Patrol searches everywhere...finally they're found! 14. Snuggled In With Love - Kaley Willow: Vocals..with guest appearance of the Skunk Family; James Coffey: Guitar, Mandolin, Harmonica, Percussion Keyboards. Blossom Skunks feels so good when she's finally home with her family after wandering away and getting lost..she just has to sing about how she feels.
