I soon met someone else to help me escape, but he was killed during a confrontation with the degenerate. I was arrested and they were asking for the death penalty because ... the victim was a United States Attorney and the government preferred the public to assume he wasnt involved with a black woman. Sooooo, because I didnt call the police, was given 6 years to life." Like Snoop Dogg said: That was the case that they gave me. The song:

No Shame, is about a prostitute. I was raised in the ghetto, where pimps and prostitutes were our role models. I began the song with a woman speaking in a my-shit-dont-stink tone because if her man didnt buy that house, Mercedes or fur coat, shed hit the road, too. Some people have asked me, "Arent you embarrassed about your past?" ... My answer is: "No, Im telling you how it is, not how you want it to be."
