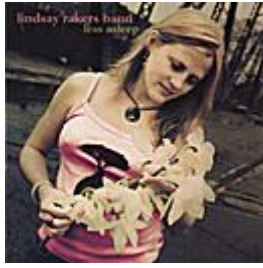


Mp3 Lindsay Rakers Band - Less Asleep
