Years after its legendary demise in 1992, Ned Henry has emerged from the wreckage of notoriously riotous East Coast phenomenon The Incredibly Drunk Brothers Band with this 25-song/ 2-CD set of original material called "The Last Resort." The music on this album is sonically rich and varied in both its style and subject matter. The emphasis this time around is on the songwriting. The songs are fresh and wholly unique but reminiscent of early Dave Matthews, David Gray, Jack Johnson, Robert Earl Keen and (very) early Jimmy Buffett without being derivative of any of these fine songwriters.
