When Carolyn met songwriting collaborator Tony DeAngelis, she found her musical soul mate. Every weekend, for three years, she and Tony worked in his tiny Upper East Side apartment birthing songs. All the while, this renaissance woman successfully held a full time job as a marketing executive at a global consulting company. After finding talented producer Doug Maxwell (who has produced Joan Osborne, Judy Collins, Ronnie Specter), she was cloistered in the recording studio for nearly a year. The result is a 10 track record that shines brightly amidst the conveyer belt pop. Carolyn has built a large following in New York City performing at renowned venues such as Joe's Pub and Roseland Ballroom, sometimes with a full band and often with just she and longtime guitarist Daniel Wachinski. At a slender 5'10" and a smile to light the stage, Carolyn's striking presence brings to mind the classic sensuality of Sade mixed with the vulnerable bravado of Annie Lennox. Living in My Skin is lifted by a stellar circle of musicians fresh off major tours. Players include guitarist Jon Herington, (Bette Midler and Steely Dan), guitarist Larry Saltzman (Simon Garfunkel), and drummer Frank Pagano who played with Laura Nyro for 15 years. Backing vocalists who appear on the album are Janice Pendarvis who has made a career singing with Sting and Vaneese Thomas, daughter of legendary R&B singer Rufus Thomas. Sandra Cisneros poetry, David Sedaris fiction, Charles and Ray Eames minimalism and Ed Ruscha art are cited as Carolyn's current inspirations.
