She was one of the first women DJ's in NYC to work the turntables of the larger clubs like Limelight, Webster Hall and Lot61 She made a name for herself spinning the legendary Monday nights at Heartbreak and China Club. While earning a living as a DJ, Dina was also making quite a lot of noise in the 90's with the Irish-American group NAKED GRAPE (Sony Music). When the Grapes broke up, She and guitarist Kieran McEvoy joined forces and formed Swamp Honey, adopting a more earthy acoustic sound. Swamp Honey became a favorite of East Village clubs like Cafe Sin-e' and CB's 323 Gallery. BE AS IT WILL is Regine's first solo effort as both an artist and producer. Most of the CD was recorded in Dina's home studio, both analog and digital. She plays acoustic electric guitar, mandolin, tenor triolian, on the CD as well as some bass and percussion.
