Their hit song Sidekick is an upbeat pop hook dedicated to Mr. Roberts students and what theyve meant to him over the past 9 years. Platform Drowning" however has a startling sense of longing and loneliness from the 31 year old popular teacher. The emotional damage wrought from songs like Normal or Smalltown is only confirmed with the powerful and heartbreaking ending on If We Could to

close out the album. The rigid dichotomy between painting a grey picture and singing the lines of a contagious hook fits well within the album "Platform Drowning."
