But moving right along,,,, for those of you who are wondering how I came up with the name to this tune ,,,,,,,,,,, the answer is simple. I just think back to when I was a little boy living with my Grandparents. I remember my Grandpa would come home, and stand at the bottom of the stairs and yell upstairs to my Grandma "HEY SLIM" wanna go for a ride. Okay for all you married guys out there here is a rule to remember. NEVER EVER leave your wife off the list when writing songs or whatever it is you're doing ,,,, because if you do BELIEVE me it's a long road home when they're mad at you....and that's no Sh@!,,,, well you know. Finding that out the hard way I wrote Ria for my wife Wendy, and trust my I tried my best to express my love for her musically because she wasn't listening to anything else when she found out I didn't write her a song. Needless to say I was out of the doghouse when she heard her song. So for you

fellas that's reading this pay close attention to what I'm about to say "ALWAYS LISTEN TO YOUR WOMAN".,,,,,, hahaha You Me was a song that I wrote about a year ago, and now that I think about it I think I wrote it for myself ,,,,,,,and for you guys "the listeners".
