She participated, at 14 years of age, in a musical (Jacob and sons) which inspired her so much that 10 years later, as a teacher, she reproduced and directed it, all from memory. While a Mass Communication student at Makerere University, her inexorable song-writing skills could be heard in radio advertising jingles. Her piano playing earned her invitations to play for various secular bands, most of which she declined. She did, however, play occasionally at her local church, Kampala Pentecostal Church. In February 1998, Charitys road rose to bring her to Boston Massachusetts. As music director at her local Church, Charity has held various roles from singing, training the choir, giving piano instruction, to leading praise and worship. Charity is a sold-out worshipper who sings from the heart, and inspires others with her piano playing. She is deeply passionate about the subject of her songs, and confesses that she lives to know Jesus and make Him known.
