At the same time the phone was ringing with requests for in-school Halloween concerts and it was decided that something had to be done. The famous Halloween knock-knock joke: "knock knock" "who's there?" "boo" "boo who?" "aw,it's just a joke, you don't have to cry about it!" provided the both the basis for the

characters' names, and the silly-spooky attitude that runs giggling through the show to this day.
