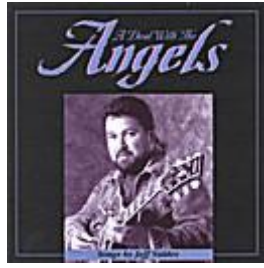


## Mp3 Jeff Valdez - A Deal With The Angels
