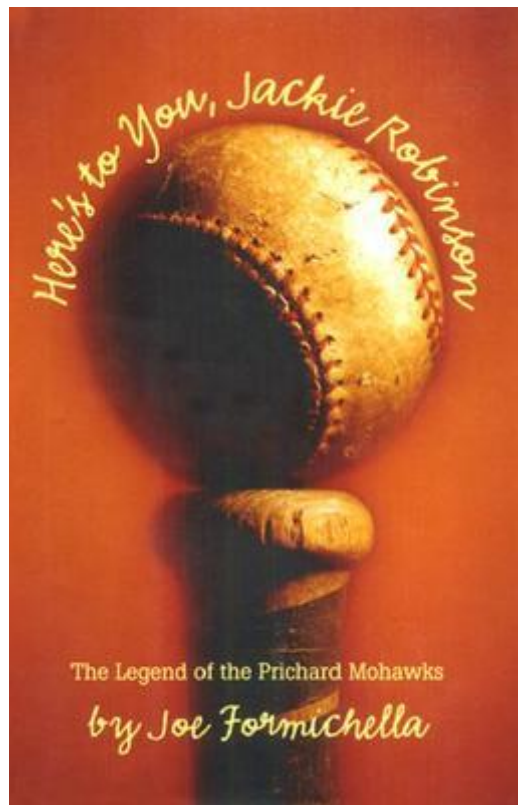


Here's To You, Jackie Robinson - Joe Formichella
