Although it never was released, she gave all her friends a copy and they loved it. As time went on Ja'meaze decided to take a break from the entertainment world and pursue a career in Physical Therapy Business Administration. Ja'Meaze attended Baltimore City Community College for one year but had a hard time

focusing on her studies. She was missing the excitement and joy of being in the spotlight, so she decided to leave college and try! her hand in the entertainment world one more time.
