Then there was Nick Drakes contradictory inability to express himself that drew me after a friend recommended I listened to Five Leafs Left. Drakes poetic lyrics combined with an obsessively accurate approach to the acoustic guitar led me to further rethink my approach to song writing. Another great songwriter from my part of the world (North London) is Richard Thompson. Ever since his days in Fairport Convention hes been intelligently combining acoustic and electric playing with well thought out lyrics. I also fell for his ironic sense of humor and live stage banter. Yes, like most songwriters I attempt to convey feelings of personal rejection or angst in my songs. But hey everyone moans on about his or her love life and - its only about 50 of the album!
