After a couple of years living in Oregon, Chris returned home and became an open mic regular at Northamptons famed music club The Iron Horse. With some encouragement from friend Stephen Kellogg, Chris moved out to Boston to try his luck in the renowned Cambridge music scene. The folks at the legendary acoustic music venue Club Passim immediately embraced the young songwriter and present him on stage on a regular basis. OBrien has also played at clubs such as CBGB in New York, The Iron Horse in Northampton and many others. Bay State Sound featured OBrien on their compilation CD, "Boston's Best Singer-Songwriter Showcase, Vol.

4." Chris has shared the stage with such artists as David Wilcox, Brian Webb, Meg Hutchinson, Antje Duvekot, Vance Gilbert, Mark Erelli, Ryan Montbleau, Rachael Davis, Anne Heaton, Jess Klein, Gregory Douglass, Jake Armerding and many others.
