All of these songs tell a story. PL Parke grew up in the mountains of East Tennessee with its rich tradition of Appalachian, bluegrass, and country music. Many of these songs are the stories of the miners, soldiers, farmers, pioneers and husbands and wives of the native land where he grew up. Often they are based on real stories and histories of the area. The thoughtful lyrics of these songs will take you places and make you stop and think about the hardships your own ancestors faced. They really hit home, as one fan likes to say. As an outdoorsman, backpacker, Native-American skills student, husband and father of three boys (and a would-be farmer) his love and respect for the land and the people of the land comes through in every song. From the popular anthem Long Leaf Pine which tells the story of the loss of the long leaf pine ecosystem in the Southeastern US to Waiting on the Water which portrays a farm family having to move off their land to make way for the new TVA dam each song is deeply rooted in the land. Try the infectious Songs for Men and see if this soldiers story with its haunting melody sticks in your head for a while. This is also, as one would expect, the kind of music I listen too. I cant get enough of the likes of Lucinda Williams and Steve Earle. I am a storyteller if anything. I only learned to play guitar to help get the stories out. I write the music and lyrics, provide the vocals and do some finger-picking on the guitar, while my friend Bob Hatcher does the song-tweaking, helps with the song selection, does the back up singing and plays most of the other instruments. Where Bob really shines through though is on his unbelievable guitar playing. From flat-picking to slide and dobro the guitar solos really stand out. Bob is a joy to listen to

anytime, no lyrics needed. He grew up playing in rock bands and is comfortable with any kind of music. I feel lucky to have him as my neighbor here in Kennesaw Georgia. We both hope you enjoy these songs and can get half as much enjoyment listening to them as we did recording them. PL Parke
