Verdi Summary: Leonora was about to elope with Alvaro, but her father, who disapproved of the pair,

caught them at the last minute. After a brief struggle, Alvaro shot Leonoras father by accident and before dying, he cursed his daughter. For revenge, Leonoras brother wants to kill her and Alvaro. So the two lovers separated and have not seen each other since. Now, for all of these years, Leonora has hidden in a cave near the church, living as a monk for safety. Through all the despair, she never stopped loving Alvaro. She asks God for peace for her tortured soul and lost love. About to eat the bread left for her by the monks, she hears the clash of swords and men shouting nearby. She curses them (Maledizione!) for trespassing on the sacred ground. What Leonora does not know is that the force of destiny has brought Alvaro back to her for one last bittersweet moment. It is Alvaro and her brother fighting nearby!
