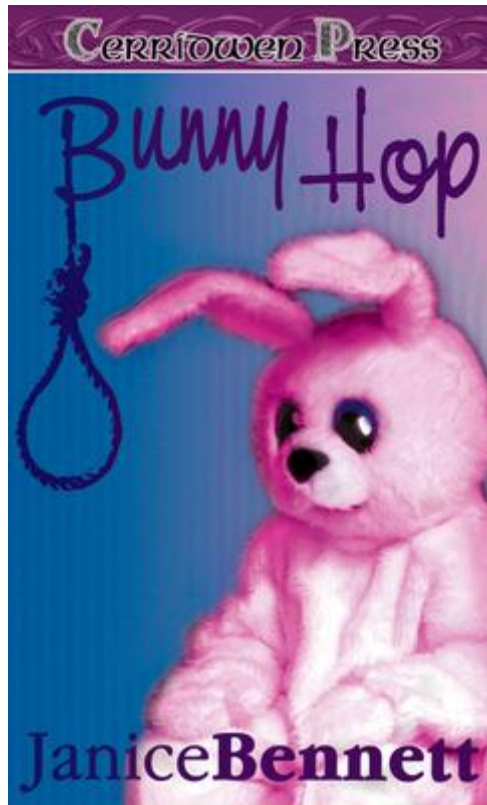


Bunny Hop - Janice Bennett
