Many of the songs were written specifically for family or friends, providing a rich background and story behind her music, also proclaiming her strong belief in Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. These powerfully composed lyrics, accompanied by acoustic guitar, soft drumming, fiddle, mandolin, and keyboarding, provide for a gentle, soft-toned mix, boldly stating her faith and standing point. Allison graduated from New Tribes Bible Institute, in Waukesha, Wisconsin, in May 2004.
