- 1 My Name Is Ben (2:01) A musical introduction to Ben, his friends and the instruments they play.
- 2 Mama Dont Low (3:09) The classic song with the band in full flight. Recorded as an ensemble, live in the studio.
- 3 Vowels (3:24) Ben and his friends love all the letters but they need Vowels to sing! A vowel-celebration. Even Y gets a mention.
4. Tuba Tune (3:48) What if Ben played the tuba instead of the guitar? A full horn section helps supply the answer. Heres a hint dancing is involved!
5. Cowgirl Song (5:04) A fresh take on a Ben

Rudnick and Friends classic featuring Buddy Cage (New Riders of the Purple Sage) on pedal steel guitar.

6. Graces Bell (3:57) When two-year old Grace gazed at Ben and rang her tricycle bell, Ben heard her spirit ring loud and clear.

7. Coming of Spring (2:26) An instrumental written in the dead of winter celebrating and eagerly anticipating the coming of spring. With Jeff Bird (Cowboy Junkies) on the bodhran.

8. Somewhere Over the Rainbow/What a Wonderful World (5:18) A beautiful rendition of the segue made famous by Hawaiian singer Iz, Israel Ka'ano'i Kamakawiwo'ole. This is musical candy!

9. Route 66 (2:03) A concert staple from their earliest live shows, this is a snippet of Ben Rudnick and Friends as you might hear them playing live on a warm summer evening. Recorded as an ensemble live in the studio.

10. Merry Go Round (3:17) RIDE! Merry-go-rounds date back to Arthurian times of knights and maidens and hold a unique place in just about everyones memory. Hold on as sights and sounds bring you along on the ride.

11. Chets Fabulous Diner (5:20) An Americana look at Bens stop into Chets Diner in Framingham, Massachusetts. With Buddy Cage (New Riders of the Purple Sage) supplying the pedal steel guitar, this song is road ready inflected country.

12. Hava Nagila (3:55) Another live show staple, the band puts their twist on this traditional song they consider older than dirt. Recorded live as an ensemble in the studio.

13. When the Saints Go Marching In (3:59) Ben Rudnick and Friends nod toward New Orleans and close the party, or at least the disc, with a celebration. The Saints are smiling! Recorded live as an ensemble in the studio.
