Fast forward to April 18th 2002 that started another chapter in his life when his mother had passed on. Dealing with thatloss as well as other personal tribulations a new man was born. During a four-month span he began writing, producing and recording at a very prolific pace in which he wrote about his pain and anger in a way that he never expected to do.
