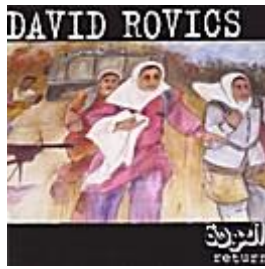


## Mp3 David Rovics - Return
