
Mp3 Patrick Fitzsimmons - The Changing

From Good Homes released three recordings for RCA and toured nationally, sharing the stage with Bob Dylan, The Dave Mathews Band, Joan Osborne and Bob Weir's Rat Dog, to name a few. In 1999 the band broke up and Patrick moved to Burlington, Vermont and embarked on a solo career. He has been touring the northeast, drawing enthusiastically attentive crowds with his soulful, captivating performances. Since embarking on his solo career, Patrick has opened shows for Ellis Paul, Lucy Kaplansky, Vance Gilbert, Steve Forbert, Cliff Eberhardt, Catie Curtis, Jeffery Foucault, Roger McGuinn, Great Big Sea, The Samples, Mark Erelli, David Wilcox and Jill Sobule. In April 2001, Patrick released his first full length CD, The Changing, to wonderful reviews and was voted as one of the top 5 Vermont releases in 2001 by Seven Days magazine. Patrick released his second CD, Dance, in 2002. Dance appeared on several top ten folk DJ lists for that year.
