

His third release, Tales to Tell is a collection of twelve songs in the lyrical acoustic style that has made James a favorite of the Northeast folk music community. James accompanies himself on acoustic guitar on all of the selections and is complimented by a small ensemble of musicians who add a sensitive embellishment to James story songs and captivating lyrics. From the opening chords of the lively Is That The Sun? to the sing along chorus of Song for Pete Seeger that open the CD, Tales To Tell offers the most memorable collection of James OMalley tunes to date. His Wrecking Ball and Give A Broken Heart A Break share a contemporary country influence while his There Was A Girl, Hell Hath No Fury and Allen Jones are in the signature story telling style that helped make James two previous releases so popular. His unique interpretation of the Bob Dylan classic, Just Like A Woman features James outstanding guitar work, which also enlivens the whimsical Crickets, where James guitar mimics the theme of the song. The intimacy of James OMalleys vocal style is at its best in his two compositions, Open a Window and the haunting The Night You Fell In Love.
