The bands first CD, 'all good things' was recorded live in December of 2004 by Xen Gargatzidis (The Exchange in Regina) and working with renowned musician/producer David j. Taylor

they released their first studio album, 'without wax' in October 2005. With an ever-evolving sound and a love of recording the members have been diligently working to compose new material.
