Then, she successfully completed, with straight A's, a three year Music Diploma at Mohawk College in Hamilton, Ontario, in 1990, where she studied classical, jazz voice and piano. She received a Music Bachelor of Fine Arts from York University in Toronto, Ontario, in 1994. Rebecca studied World Music-particularly music from Japan, India, and Africa, and at the same University in 1998, Rebecca received her Master of Arts in World Dance. In total Rebecca has successfully completed 9 years of post secondary education, plus one year of hairdressing school to become a hair stylist. Her dedication to learning has equip Rebecca for the work she believes God has call her to do in ministry. It is simply amazing to witness all that Rebecca has accomplished in her life and still see her want to do more in spite of her illness and amount of personal loss. Tragedy To Victory Rebecca lost three brothers to suicide, and her mother to liver disease. These losses have profoundly shaped her. A burden is on the

Rebecca was also involved as a missionary sent to work in an Egyptian orphanage, and has done missionary work in Canada, at a Saskatchewan Native camp. Her faith has reached out to a variety of needs in various communities, everything from troubled youth to seniors homes across Canada. Rebecca's passion to see others healed fuels her onward in the ministries she and her husband Peter are committed to as faithful servants of God.
