(1992-1993)...32 city tour, headlining with queen latifa, rob bass, big daddy kane, tupac, nwa, young mc, mc hammer, father mc,kwame,house of pain,biggy smalls,digital underground,king sun,ice cube,the lynchmob,heavy-d and many others, soulcats stage show blew fans minds as he performed with re-freshing ideas that many rap artist still use today...(those biters) (1993)...mca released soulcats new smash "give the people what they want" a remake of the isley bros. hit song remixed with a george clinton atomic dog funk vibe, soulcats solo-debut sizzled all over the nation like a california wildfire gaining major radio play and heavy vidieo rotation.soulcat also enjoyed countless press cover layouts and interviews in magazines like the source, rappin' and the b.r.e. (1995-2004)...\$oulcat began to receive offers to write by other artist who took note of his creative style and innovative songwriting ability such as paula abdul, the def dames, all 4 one, college boys, scat cat, coldjimmy, the desert pharroz, reba jackson and many others who may not want it to be known and countless other emcee's who flatter soulcat by copy cattin" his stlye or counterfiet hooks or lyric's they heard soulcat say...(break bread)... (2005-today)...soulcat remains on the cutting edge of hip hop, trendsetting a new form of funk and rap called "pimp hop musik"
