His affinities for these different genres lead him to begin writing songs of various styles at around age 16. As high school neared an end, Sam decided to make music his primary career goal. Anything music, including writing, performing, producing and teaching, Sam wanted to be a part of. He auditioned and was accepted into the music department at Providence College in Providence, Rhode Island, where he received his Bachelors Degree in Music Education. After graduating Providence College, Sam moved to Miami where he entered the SAE Institute of Miami earning a diploma in Audio Engineering. Upon completion of his diploma, Sam was accepted into the Frost School of Music at the University of Miami where he received his Master's of Music Degree in Media Writing and

Production. Sam began his music production career while at the University of Miami, mixing an album for Bay-Area artist Cava Menzies, as well as co-producing and mixing the debut album of the University of Miami/'Cane Records recording artist LES. Sam had the pleasure of mixing LES' album with grammy winning engineer Mark Roofe. Sam's music has been featured on ABC programming such as the NBA Playoffs, Jimmy Kimmell live, and Good Morning America.
