'a chuisle mo chro", pulse of my heart - in English "heart throb" My Darling.] This song was 1st recorded by the famous Irish tenor John Francis McCormack one of the greatest singers of this century. Born in Athlone, Ireland, 14 June 1884, died 16 September 1945. He was the first artist to record the World War One hit song It's a Long Way to Tipperary, in 1914. Macushla was recorded by John 30 March 1911. Enjoy my version
