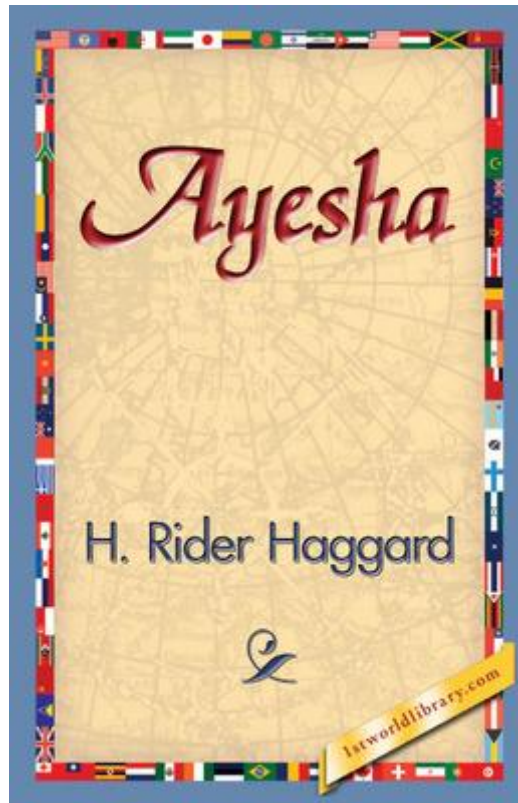


Ayesha - H. Rider Haggard
