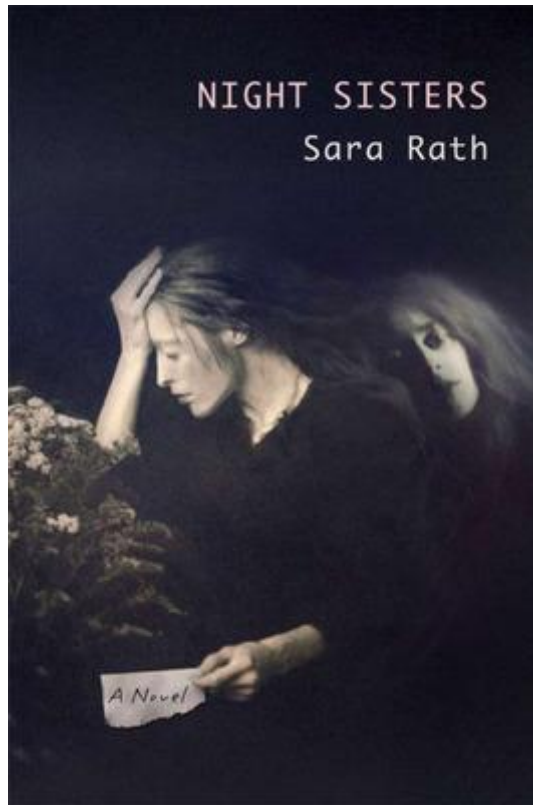


Night Sisters: A Novel - Sara Rath
