Also Josh Foster from Crazy Fingers Band, Chad Moye, and Dean Fishback from Revelation Sound. The Apocalypse Project, Ija's first studio effort, is a collection of songs with a variety of themes and sounds that unite into one harmonious whole. When heard separately, each song is unique, but when experienced collectively,

the album resounds with a compelling message for the people - a message that reflects the sign of the times. Inspired by the Book of Revelation, "Apocalypse Century" is a powerful and melodic arrangement with a hard-hitting reggae beat.
