The album is a high-energy mashup of punk, jungle, and protest influences. "I want to bring a sense of urgency and energy to political issues that can be depressing and, sadly, mundane." "It is political but I try not to preach. Each song takes a simple idea, traces it from a certain angle or boils it down to a chorus. I want people to sing along, to carry a song in their heads, absorb the message, draw on that energy in their daily lives."
