Time, Naomi had a stillborn son, Brady. The depth of her anguish was expressed in the composition of Brady's Song, dedicated to her son's memory. Then in September 2005, Naomi suffered yet another stillbirth, her daughter, Danielle. Upon learning the tragic news, Naomi painfully cried out, "Not Again!" Subsequently, while grieving the loss of Danielle, she composed Danielle's Song, in addition to the inspirational ballad, Not Again. This song depicts both the pain of having lost two children, yet finding the strength to carry on because of her deep faith in God and the love of her family and friends. All three titles are included in Naomi's latest album, From My Heart. She has been invited to speak and share these poignant songs with other families who have suffered similar losses. Naomi acknowledges that her musical abilities are a gift from God, and is honored to be able to bless, encourage and perhaps even inspire others through her music.
