Her Dad told her the piano was an investment and that she had to take private lessons until she was 18 years old, with no complaints or questions asked. Sarah began her piano lessons. By the time she was nine, she wanted to play the flute as well. By the time Sarah was in high school, she was taking private lessons in both piano and flute, involved with the school wind ensemble, participating in a number of solo ensemble events, competitions and performances. The last two years of high school, she was accepted into the California Youth Symphony and toured with that group to England, France, and Wales. When Sarah reached college, she left her music behind. Sarah graduated from Michigan State University with honors and a bachelor's degree in Biochemistry. She has spent the last 8 years as a scientist, a process engineer, and a project manager in the semiconductor, cancer research, pharmaceutical, and energy industries. She currently works at Grand Valley State University at the Michigan Alternative and Renewable Energy Center as the Biomass Project Manager to help facilitate the build of an Anaerobic Biodigester Plant on a Dairy Farm in Ravenna Michigan to convert cow manure into biogas and subsequently into electricity.
