Don has been playing guitar and writing since the late 1960s and started recording with a Digital Home Studio in late 2006. The only full overdubs used were on IMAGERY, MOSQUITO CREEK, and FIRST SNOW. All music was played on a Taylor 814CE 6 string guitar, a National Steel Radio Tone Resophonic 6 string guitar, and a Giannini 12 string Craviola. Don has written over 80 instrumental compositions for 6-string 12-string guitar and has performed at various local functions. His time is spent actively writing, playing, and recording guitar music; photography and work as an architect.
