What most of us do understand is driving around in a bucket like it's a Lexus, or breaking off a rough relationship with someone. He works with hip-hop producers Kevin Choice (whom produced half the album), Dame Taylor and Aristotle, producers who Tony Vic believes are some of the best in their field. And working in that field isn't easy. For Tony Vic, struggles are endless: he says he's proving himself to people, to God, and to my family. Not being out on the streets selling dope. He isn't about struggling on the streets and following trends because, simply put, his dreams are hard enough. When Tony Vic writes, he needs to be in a mood one that rises from emotions or pains. This lyricist does not let stress keep him down. He actually feeds from it to help him strive and work harder. When asked what makes him different from other rappers, he says, I'm not afraid to be myself, and talk about my insecurities, my heart, my struggles, my pain, my love, my life, my tears,

and my fears. And so even when he writes a party joint, he needs to be inspired by anything thatll trigger those universal motifs shared by individuals. And sharing this poetry comes about easily for Tony Vic through the mic. He feels as though the microphone doesnt judge: It doesnt hate on you, it wont clown on you or classify you. It just listens.
