Thomascows version of the Wild Colonial Boy, It first appeared in print circa 1830. The rogue is also called Jack Donohue, Jack Doogan, and Jack Duggan. He was transported to Australia, escaped and resumed a life of crime, but was eventually shot in 1830. Jack Dowling a bushranger in the 1870s was recognized with many of the same offences: he shared the same fate. Castlemaine, an Irish market-town, situated on the harbour, on the north side of the river Maine and lies south-east of the Slieve Mish range of mountains. The Maine flows into the harbour of Castlemaine. To the west of the town lies the ruins of Castledrum, there the Australian outlaw, was born.
