His childhood in the Ozark Mountain farming community of Lebanon, Missouri, reads like something out of Mark Twain. His life took an unexpected detour when he met with almost immediate success; within a year he had bought the real estate company for which he worked. With a successful business and a growing family he had no desire to climb aboard a tour bus for a life on the road, but music was still his greatest love. He hit upon the idea of a live country music variety show located in a resort area where a tourist audience could come to him. Fond memories of earlier vacation trips led him to Myrtle Beach, and thus The Carolina Opry was born.
